FOR FURTHER THOUGHT & GROWTH GROUP STUDY

1. What are some of the reasons why leadership is hard today? How can we find a balance between blind support and distrust?
2. What does Paul mean by “double honor”? How does the immediate context help us understand what Paul means? Look at the following passages where the same Greek word is used, but translated differently: Acts 4:34 (“proceeds”), Acts 7:16 (“sum”), 1 Corinthians 6:20 (“price”). What are some ways (besides pay) in which we can show double honor to our leaders?
3. When Paul tells the church not to entertain an accusation against an elder unless it is brought by two or three witnesses (v19), is he asking for more protection than anyone else gets? See Matthew 18:15-17 (and look at v20) before you answer!
4. How can we be developing leaders at all levels of ministry? If you’re in leadership, do you have someone you’re grooming to succeed you?
5. How can the church make room at the table for “young eagles”? Who are the young eagles you can identify here at Cornerstone, and how can you encourage them?
