For students in 7th-12th grade - *Dig Deeper!*

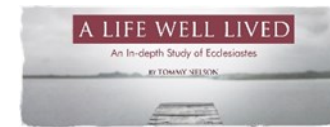
- Students - Please check in at the Multi-Purpose Room (Education Center) before going to class and check out there when class ends.

1. Describe a situation where you felt overly self-conscious. What about the situation contributed to that feeling? How did you get over it?
2. Read Mark 14:53-72. Note the two scenes and make as many observations as you can about how the scenes are similar. Next, observe how they are different. What are some of the biggest differences between how Jesus responds to his accusers and how Peter does?
3. Read Mark 8:34-35. What does Jesus say is the first thing necessary in order to be his disciple? What does it look like to deny oneself in the 21st Century in order to follow Christ?
4. Read Mark 14:72. How does Peter's response to what has just occurred demonstrate how we should respond when confronted with our own tendencies toward self-preservation?
5. Read Mark 16:1-8. How does the specific mention of Peter in the resurrection scene inform us about how God received his brokenness?
6. Take a few moments for reflection. How have you over-focused on yourself? How is God calling you to refocus your thinking and doing? Ask Him for the courage to deny yourself and remain faithful to Him, regardless of the cost.
