Please note there will be no childcare available at the Christmas Eve Services.





- 1. What is the greatest challenge to your experience of peace at this stage of your life? Describe a season of your life when you experienced the greatest amount of peace. What made it that way?
- 2. Read Genesis 2:1-3. What is the significance of God's rest on the seventh day? Read Genesis 3:6-7. When the eyes of Adam and Eve were opened, what did they realize? Read Genesis 3:16-19. How did their decision to reject God's rest affect their experience of peace?
- 3. Read Jeremiah 6:13-15. What is the context for the false prophets in this passage? What are the consequences of their false proclamations of peace?
- 4. Read Psalm 34:18 and Isaiah 57:15. How do these passages inform us about how God treats those who are broken?
- 5. Read Romans 5:8-11. How has Christ restored peace for those who trust in Him?
- 6. Read Philippians 4:6-7. Thank God for the peace that is yours and ask Him to help you to apply it in every area of your life.
