Hello Cornerstone! Congratulations on the launch of your Blueprints and planned together. Campaign. It's exciting to see what God has done over the past 24 years.

Cornerstone started meeting weekly in the Grant Elementary School gym in February of 2000, but its beginning goes back a couple of years earlier.

A group of families had been interested in starting an Evangelical Free church for some time. REACHING CAPACITY

Cornerstone has seen major growth in 2023, which means we're running out of space.

- Sunday Church Attendance: +16%
- Infant-12 Grade Ministries: +27%
- Kids Rock Ministries: +5%
- CSM (Jr. & Sr. High) Ministry: +28%
- Office space is limited, with one pastor using storage space to fulfill his duties



Frequently Asked Questions

Why do we need to expand our facilities at this time?

Cornerstone is growing! Praise God. This has occurred across all ministries...kids, students, and adults. We are constantly strapped for space. Kids and Student Ministries must happen on separate nights because they currently share the same ministry space. By providing new space for our student ministry, we make it possible for kids and students to have their own dedicated spaces. This means they will be able to meet on the same night. We also need to expand office space in line with the growth of staff, as well as additional spaces for adult ministries.

What are the specific plans for the project?

The plans are focused on 3 areas...

- Updating the exterior and interior of the Blue Building. We need to address not only the functionality of the Blue Building, but also its exterior, as it presents Cornerstone's face to the community. The goal is to present more of an open and inviting front door.
- Adding a new Student Ministries area off the north side of our building
- Adding additional spaces for offices and adult ministries

What is the timeline for the campaign and building project?

- Capital Campaign Spring 2024
- Design/Development Summer 2024
- Breaking Ground Late Fall 2024
- Grand Opening Fall 2025

What is our goal for the project?

Our current project cost is \$3.6 million and so our goal in the Campaign is to see God's people respond so that the project can be completed with minimal borrowing. We are open to borrowing within our means to fulfill the project goals. Incurring less debt, however, means more future opportunities for ministry in other areas. Because of fluctuations in market conditions and interest rates, exact details of things such as maximum loan capacity will be determined at a time closer to when the project begins.

Does the church currently have any debt?

The church paid off its previous mortgage in 2021 and is currently DEBT FREE. Our expectation is that donations through the Blueprints campaign will provide a significant amount (or perhaps all) of the funding to be used to launch the project.

Will the church accept donations from employers of Cornerstone people?

Yes! We encourage you to check with your employer or others who may support our mission to see if they have a matching funds program or something similar. Many companies offer programs like this. Let us know how we can help.

If the Campaign is not able to raise enough money, will the project be delayed?

Depending on the results of the Campaign, if needed, the Elders will then evaluate with input from the Building Team to determine the best way to proceed with the Building Project. Some aspects of the project may be completed, or the project may be delayed. The elders will ensure open communication with the congregation throughout the process.

Who will know what I've committed to the Campaign?

Your commitment will be known by our church Treasurer and Bookkeeper. This is basically the same as how your regular offerings are handled.

What if I can't fulfill my commitment?

The commitment you make to the Campaign will be between you and God, trusting Him to enable you to give. If for whatever reason you are unable to meet your commitment, that too will be between you and God. No one will come knocking on your door.

That fall, we began having 'pre-view' services once a month in the Grant School as we prepared for our launch. Word began to spread of what was happening and the Lord began to add to our number. God was at work and we could all sense His hand with us during those days.

Once February rolled around, we felt we were ready to begin weekly services. We had our official public launch on Easter Sunday of April 2000. We were so excited about what we saw God doing we could hardly contain ourselves. God was bringing us families and adding to our number. It was an exciting time, but it was also stretching our faith. Each Saturday night we would set up the stage, sound system, chairs and projection and then all return the

next morning to a transformed gym to see God transforming lives.

God was building His Church. We were all growing and learning together...(and failing sometimes, as well). After 2 years of meeting in the school gym, the current property became available on McMillan Street. Stepping out in faith, we purchased the property and after some painting and minor renovations we moved in to our new church home. The church continued to grow and eventually in 2008, by the grace of God, we built the current Worship Center.

God used different people at different times to accomplish His purposes. May you continue to play your part in whatever the Lord has for you at this stage of your life.
