Walk in the Spirit

Ephesians 5:15-21

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1. Describe some ways in which you are active in the pursuit of those things which are important to you? What particularities or devices do you employ to engage in those activities?
2. Read Ephesians 5:15–20. What is Paul’s exhortation to the church? Why do you think Paul encourages this? What about human nature makes this kind of teaching particularly important for a people who wish to honor God in their walking?
3. Read Ephesians 5:18. What does the grammar indicate for how a believer is to respond to this exhortation? Why does Paul contrast drunkenness with the filling of the Spirit? How does Paul explain the means by which the Spirit does his filling?
4. Read Ephesians 1:23 and 3:14–19. Who is the Spirit filling the church with? Why?
5. How is God calling you to partner with the Spirit in being filled with the fullness of Christ? Ask God to teach you how to be active in your faith and to trust Him for the activity of His Spirit as well.
