

1. What aged person in your life have you wanted to learn from? Why? What character or knowledge did they possess that made them compelling to you?
2. Read 2 Samuel 22:1–20. List the ways that David speaks about God in this passage. Why, as David looked back on his life, were these things important to remember?
3. Read 2 Samuel 22:21–25. How do we understand reward in light of what David shares in these verses? What is the reward for those who trust in Jesus?
4. Read 2 Samuel 22:26–51. How has God been David's supply and sustainer? What about this points to God's grace?
5. Read David's final speech in 2 Samuel 23:1–7. What is David trying to impart in this final opportunity to address the nation of Israel? Why do you think this mattered to David? What confidence does his speech give you about God and his activity?
6. Invite the Spirit of God to let David's reflections and expectations shape your view of God and inform your expectations for God. And thank Him that, in Jesus, our future is secure.
