

1. Describe a time when you heard or saw something beautiful and it reminded you of God's glory. What about your experience made you think of God? How did you respond?
2. Read Luke 1:31-33. What two OT passages do these verses reflect? Why are they important in the Virgin Birth Narrative?
3. In Luke 1:31, Gabriel says that Mary "will conceive and bear a son." Why is it important that Jesus has a human mother? How does his humanity come to bear on our experience of Him?
4. In 1:32, Gabriel calls the child "the Son of the Most High." Why must we understand the deity of Christ in order to understand his true nature and character?
5. Spend some time reviewing the chart and reading the references. How do Jesus' ministries play out in each of the areas as God and man?
6. Read Philippians 2:5-11. How does the humanity and deity of Jesus work out in this passage? How does it deepen our understanding of and appreciation for the incarnation of Christ at Christmas?
7. Take a few moments to listen again to the piece of music Andy reference in the sermon.
