

# TO GO

1. Have you ever had a home project go awry? What about it was particularly difficult? How did it get resolved?
2. Read Genesis 3:1–5. In what ways does the conversation between the serpent and Eve reflect God’s mandate from Genesis 2:16–17? In what ways does it distort it? How do people sometimes fall into the trap of becoming “wobbly with God’s Word”? In what ways do you see this occurring most frequently in your experience? How can we avoid this?
3. Read Genesis 3:7. How did sin affect Adam and Eve’s relationship with each other?
4. Read Genesis 3:8–13. How did sin affect their relationship with God?
5. Read Genesis 3:16–19, 22–24. How did the curse affect Adam and Eve’s experience of God’s Edenic rest? Read Romans 5:12–21. How does Paul indicate the sin of Adam has affected mankind? What is the remedy?
6. Read Genesis 3:8, 12–13, 20–21, 14–15. How do these passages indicate God making the fallen world ready for redemption?
7. How are you trying to cover your own shame today? In what ways do you need to confess your sin and allow God to reclothe you with grace? Ask him to do just that right now.
