- 1. What's been your experience in keeping a tidy living space?

 Describe the things that work against that space remaining as you desire.
- 2. Read John 2:12–14. What is the scenario in Jerusalem that Jesus encounters in these verses? Why is this such a violation of his values?
- 3. Read John 2:15–17. Why does Jesus react the way that he does? How does this conflict with how many of us like to typically think about Jesus? Why were his actions justified?
- 4. Read Psalm 69:9. Why was Jesus (and David) "consumed" with God's house?
- 5. Read John 2:18–20. What does the question of the Jews have to do with authority? Why is Jesus' response so wise?
- 6. Read John 2:21–22. What do the disciples remember upon Jesus' resurrection? Why is it significant that John describes the temple as Jesus' body in v21? What implications does that have for today's church?
- 7. Read John 2:23–25. Why do you think John includes this passage in its current location? Why do people tend to fixate on signs more than a Savior? How can the church resist this fixation and honor what's been made available to us, now through Christ? How can you do that personally?
