- 1. Thinking back, what is one time of celebration you won't forget. What made it so memorable for you?
- 2. Why do you think that God had Israel celebrate the Passover once a year and the church celebrate the Lord's Supper more frequently? "*For whenever* you eat this bread and drink this cup..." -1 Cor 11:26

- 3. Why is it easy for us to live like we haven't been truly forgiven of all our sins? **Suggestion**: Make a note in the front or back of your Bible with a list of verses that clearly teach we have been fully forgiven.
- 4. If someone were to ask you the following question based off your takeaway from today's message how would you answer? "*If you have been forgiven of all your sins, then why do you still have to confess your sins?*"
- 5. In what ways does God intend the '*promise of His coming'* to make a difference in our lives today?
- 6. How can you better prepare for celebrating the Lord's Supper this year?
