4. Read Genesis 13:10-13 and 19:1-11. Trace the ways Lot walked by sight and not by faith. How did the sin of Sodom infiltrate his heart, and how can we learn from him?
5. Read Genesis 19:12-26. When have you been on a path to your own destruction, and God "grabbed you by the wrist"?
6. List some ways we might be tempted to "look back" at the good life around us, rather than submit to God's plan.
7. Read Genesis 19:27-29. Who has God put on your heart to persistently pray for? Pause and pray for them right now.
