1. Share an example of a life decision that was difficult to trust God for. How did you discern whether God was leading you in that decision?
2. Read Genesis 24:1–9. How does Abraham demonstrate his resolve to live by faith?
3. Read Genesis 24:10–15. How does the servant’s prayer demonstrate trust in the resource of the Lord? How can we apply his prayer to our lives?
4. Read Genesis 24:16–27. How does the text display the servant’s faith? Why is it significant that the servant praises God? What can we learn about walking with God from the servant?
5. Read Genesis 24:28–58. How does Rebekah demonstrate her readiness to be a participant in God’s covenant blessing of Abraham?
6. How does Laban’s reluctance indicate how we sometimes view the activity of God in our lives?
7. Read Genesis 24:59–25:18. What reward is there specifically for Rebekah? Then, what reward does God supply for Abraham’s descendants?
8. What does it look like for you to walk with God by faith today? What mess have you created that you need to confess? Read 1 John 1:9 and remember that if God can use the messy faith of Abraham, he can do the same in you. Invite him to let his grace wash over you and commit to walking by faith as Abraham did.
