2. What would it have been like for the disciples to watch Jesus pray? What would they have seen? What would they have heard?

Read Luke 11:1-4

3. What does it mean that God is our Abba Father (v2)? How should this intimate and deeply personal relationship with God shape how we pray?
4. What does it mean to “hallow” God’s name?
 - How can we become aware of God’s holiness when we pray?
5. What does it mean to pray for God’s kingdom to come in the present? In the future?
 - What are some indicators we’ve become more concerned about our personal “kingdom” rather than God’s Kingdom?
6. What physical and material needs (daily bread) are you praying for?
7. Through faith in Christ we receive forgiveness of sins. So why is it important to keep asking God for forgiveness?
8. Why is prayer vital to overcoming temptation?

9. What aspects of the Lord’s Prayer do you gravitate toward naturally?
10. What aspects do you tend to neglect?
11. What is God prompting you to do in light of this prayer?
