TO GO

- 1. Describe a time when you were asked to do something without any explanation of why you were asked to do it or how what you were asked to do fit within a bigger picture. How did it make you feel? How did it affect your motivation?
- 2. Read 1 Chronicles 28:1-8. What direction did God give the people of Israel at this point? Why was it critical that they understood this as a shared and missional direction? How might their participation with God have been affected without this clarity?
- 3. Read 1 Chronicles 28:9. Why do you think David found it so important to communicate to Solomon the importance of the "heart over hands" principle? What about David's experience may have made him something of an expert in this area?
- 4. Read 1 Chronicles 28:10. What specific and clear vision did David cast for Solomon and for Israel? How did building the temple fit into God's missional plan for the nation?
- 5. Read 1 Chronicles 28:11-19. What are some of the specifics of the plan? Why was it so important that the people follow the plan God had given them?
- 6. Read 1 Chronicles 28:20-21. What would be required of Solomon and of the people to see this vision become a reality?
- 7. Please begin to pray about what it will look like for you and your family to participate in the BluePrints campaign. Stay tuned to the coming communication pieces and be sure to ask if you lack any clarity about the vision.
