

1. Have you ever experienced a bait and switch? Maybe in a sales context, or online, or at school? What were the circumstances? How did it make you feel? How did you respond?
2. Read Mark 1:14–45. What do you notice about the onset of Jesus’ ministry? What seems to be important to him as he calls his disciples? How does he demonstrate this with his actions? What aspects of Jesus’ practice here are transferrable to us as we interact with people?
3. Why do we tend to emphasize either declaration over demonstration or vice versa, demonstration over declaration? How does Jesus keep things in balance? And maybe more importantly, why does he keep these things in balance?
4. Read Luke 10:1–2. What priority does Jesus give his disciples as he prepares them to go out into the world to share the gospel? Why is this so important?
5. Read Luke 11:5–13. Why is prayer so important and what can we expect when we pray?
6. In what ways can we pray for those on our FRANC list? Use Jeremiah 29:7 and 1 Timothy 2:1–4 as prompts.
7. Make a commitment to begin praying for the people on your FRANC list every time you gather with other believers and every time you go to the Lord in prayer as a part of your personal worship. Then, look for opportunities to pray with and for your neighbor.
8. Have any God-sightings along the way? If you see God show up, share it with someone. It will encourage their faith and prayers for others as well!
