

# TO GO

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1. Many kids growing up in the 1980's and 1990's wanted to "be like Mike (Michael Jordan)." How about you? Who did you look up to when you were growing up?
2. Is there a character in the Bible that you relate to? Perhaps you're task-oriented like Martha or outspoken like Peter? Maybe you've shown great faith like Noah or you've lacked faith like Gideon? Who are you like (in the Bible)? Explain.
3. Prior to today, how much did you already know about the Apostle Andrew? Have you ever thought he's someone we (followers of Jesus) should aspire to be like?
  - a. How are you like the Apostle Andrew already? What characteristics do you have in common?
  - b. How are you different from him? What areas do you need to grow in to be more like Andrew?
4. Today's text is clear that Andrew brought his brother, Simon (Peter), to Jesus because he was convinced of WHO Jesus was/is. What have *you* been compelled to DO because of your faith in Jesus?
5. Consider the boy in John 6, who had 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish, that Jesus blessed and multiplied to feed over 5,000 people. Pause and dream a little bit. What do you think his (the boy) life was like after that miracle?
  - a. Now imagine if it happened today with the modern cell phone and social media. What would his life be like in this day and age?
  - b. Lastly, think about the people in your life (FRANC - Friends, Relatives, Acquaintances, Neighbors, Co-Workers) that *you* could bring to Jesus. Now imagine & share what Jesus could do in and through them if they trust Jesus & follow Him...
6. Who brought you to Jesus? Share that story with someone and then give thanks to that person. If they're no longer with us, pause and give thanks to God for that person.
